Dear National Cadet Class Associations,

The Executive Committee is seeking expressions of interest in hosting the class's **World Championships** in **2021, 2022** and **2023**.

The 2019 and 2020 events are of course settled with POL and AUS respectively hosting those Championships.

While NCCAs have offered to host 2021 and 2022 we believe it is healthy for the class that we should have an open process in appointing host nations for our headline annual regatta.

Hosting a **Cadet World Championship** is a significant responsibility not to be taken on lightly, however NCCAs which have not hosted an event before, or not for many years, are encouraged to consider doing so. The Class has considerable expertise in regatta management and can provide a high level of advice and assistance.

The Class has very detailed Event **Guidelines** on our website. If ICC accepts an NCCAs expression of interest, all the points in the Event Guidelines must be addressed in the formal bid and signed by the NCCA President, forming the basis of the contract between the ICC and the NCCA.
