**CLASS RULE D.1.4(d) APPROVAL OF THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE TO
A VARIATION OF THE INTERNAL DETAILS OF THE CONSTRUCTION
OF CERTAIN HULLS**

The Technical Committee of the International Cadet Class Association acting under Class Rule D.1.4(d) authorises the internal details of the construction of the hulls of the following boats to be varied as set out below:

Hulls to which this authorisation applies: Mark IV hulls originally built by Capel under the Capel licence.

Variation authorised to internal details:

- Internal floor battens may be fitted.
- These floor battens may be wood or g.r.p. (glass reinforced plastic).
- Any g.r.p. or adhesive used to make or attach the battens shall consist only of polyester resin and E-Glass (in chopped strand or woven form), but foam or wood cores or parts may be incorporated.
- No part of the upper surface of any floor batten shall be more than 20mm from the outside of the hull.
- There shall be no other restriction on the dimensions of the floor battens.
- For the purpose of attaching the floor battens the hull laminate may be abraded or removed.

This authorisation does not in any way dispense with the requirement that any hull to which floor battens are fitted must comply with all the class rules applicable to it.
